#### **Board of Directors Meeting**

#### Amendment to the Bylaws

President Roger M. Olien would like to remind the membership that at the spring meeting he will recommend a vote to abolish of the office of executive director. This vote will be a change in the bylaws. The office of executive director has not been functioning for several years and the membership previously authorized the president to leave the office vacant.

#### Permian Archives at the University

Permian Historical Society's archives at The University of Texas of the Permian Basin will be open more hours per week to researchers and its scope and usability will be increased as the result of a recent donation. The El Paso Products Company and J. Conrad Dunagan are the joint donors of \$2500, which will be used to increase the number of hours per week the state archival worker can spent in the archives. The donation will also furnish some funding for travel to acquire collections and for the purchase of supplies.

The donation will be administered by the Ector County Historical Commission and it will cover the period through 31 August 1980.
